

CITY OF WALLER TRASH COLLECTION & RECYCLING

Notice to all hand-pick-up garbage customers:

The Waller City Council has a contract with Allied Waste / Republic Services for solid waste disposal. This contract provides customers with the following:

- One 95-gallon poly-cart with wheels per service address.
Note: Poly-carts are bar-coded and are to remain with the street address. Poly-carts are the property of Allied Waste / Republic Services and there is no fee charged if a cart needs to be replaced.

Bulk Item Pick-Up

Bulk item pickup will be on the 1st Monday of each month at no additional charge. This service will be limited to four (4) bulk items per residence.

To take advantage of this service, simply contact Allied Waste / Republic Services at 979-277-1160 or e-mail thoermann@republicservices.com by noon on the Saturday prior to the 1st Monday and give your name and address for pick up.

The City of Waller requests that you not place these items at the curb until three (3) days prior to the scheduled pick up.

Acceptable bulk items: limit (4)

- Household Appliances
- (Refrigerators must have Freon drained and be tagged accordingly by certified technician)
- Hot Water Heaters-must be drained
- Furniture
- Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes - no propane tanks
- Bundled brush (not to exceed 4' in length or 50 lbs, tied and easily handled by one person)
- Bags
- 32 Gallon trash receptacles

Unacceptable bulk items:

- Wood
- Carpet
- Nails
- Tile
- Sheetrock or drywall
- Paneling
- Windows
- Doors
- Insulation
- Masonry debris
- Stone
- Roofing material
- Tree trunks
- Pool filters
- Water softeners
- Lawn mowers

- Tires
- Concrete
- Steel or cast iron building materials
- Dirt in large quantity

Recycling

Recycling services are free to all City of Waller residents, year-round. (Proof of residency within the City limits must be provided.) Recycling is single stream (no need to separate); however all containers must be emptied and rinsed clean.
